Pineview Homes Annual PREA Report 2022

Pineview Homes contracts with the State of Michigan to provide juvenile justice residential services and is, therefore, required to adopt and comply with all standards of the federal Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA). Pineview Homes' PREA Policy states that all agency personnel have zero tolerance for sexual abuse and sexual harassment of residents. Facilities must have preventive plans in place and, should allegations regarding sexual abuse or harassment be made, all personnel must be appropriately trained to take action to rapidly restore safety, attend to and support the victim, and promptly initiate the investigative process. Audits are required to ensure compliance with PREA standards.

Reporting Sexual Abuse or Harassment

- Pineview Homes' policy requires that all residential facilities provide youths with multiple ways to report sexual abuse and harassment, including suspected sexual abuse, and youth must be given an orientation on the multiple reporting options available to them. Facilities must ensure that youth who report sexual abuse or harassment and supporting witnesses are protected from retaliation. Facilities must inform youth that they will be protected from retaliation. Reporting options include:
- Verbally or in writing to any staff, counselor or administrator.
- In writing through the youth and family grievance process.
- Verbally or in writing to an advocate or parent.
- Externally by telephoning Children's Protective Services (CPS) at (855) 444-3911.
- Any member of the public that suspects sexual abuse or sexual harassment is occurring has occurred at the facility may also report by calling CPS.

Reporting and Allegation Statistics during calendar year 2022:

- Pineview Homes are required to keep a record of all allegations of youth-on-youth and staff-on-youth nonconsensual sexual acts, contact, or harassment, whether the allegation was substantiated or no.

- In 2022, there were zero (0) substantiated youth-on-youth non-consensual sexual acts and zero (0) staff-on-youth sexual acts, contact, or harassment, either substantiated or unsubstantiated.
- There was one unsubstantiated allegation for youth-on-youth inappropriate sexual contact.
